A prototype gun was received from the custom shop at Ilion. Its the Model 700 classic, with a 9" twist and 24" barrel.

The Safari ammo was handloaded and shipped overnight on 6-17-93 to marketing.

The test barrels were returned and measure to be correct chamber dimensions. Some shooting will be done to calibrate the barrels.
