Thank you for your patience. We began production about mid-year on the 710 without the ISS safety. We apologize for the confusion. The 710 and the 597 will no longer have the ISS safety after 2004.

Your Model 700 was probably produced before 1982. Your rifle was originally installed with a bolt-lock, which means you have to put the safety switch on fire before you can open the bolt. We are offering a conversion at a special price if you would like your firearm converted, so that you can open the bolt at anytime with the safety on safe.
