Hey Chris-

I got some oil for the Bolt it is working great now. I am still having a problem with the safety I will try to better explain the situation so we can maybe resolve it over the email system, when the gun is unloaded without a shell in the chamber and the bolt action has not been cocked the safety will only stay in the F position it will not go to S, but if I release the bolt from the chamber or if I load the gun and cock it it will go into the S position, this is not crucial because I can still put it into S when it is loaded or when I store in my case and have taken the bolt out, but if I am taking it to the range and to my hunting location and have the bolt in without it being loaded I can't not put it in the S position which 1) makes people a little uneasy and 2) I worry that there may be something wrong with the safety mechanism and it might mess up when it is loaded so I hope I have better explained the situation, I know this sounds very weird, but I can not figure it out to save my life and it isn't the easiest thing to explain, thank you so much for your time, and let me know what you find out.
