- **History**
  - Why build it?
  - Why sell it?
  - Developed by our R&D facility and produced in our Mayfield, Ky. factory.
- **Features and Benefits**
  - 3 bolt lugs lock directly into the barrel.
  - Barrel hydraulically pressed into action.
  - Button rifled barrel.
  - ~~2005 action sleeves are extruded steel~~
- Standard long action and magnum calibers for most medium to large North American game.
- The *best* rifle on the market for beginning shooters and hunters.

  - Descendant of the 740, introduced in 1955
