

What Makes the Model 700 Great?

Receivers are machined from solid bar stock which makes them uniformly strong and consistent. (see Picture 1)

Receivers are cylindrical which results in more consistent bedding in the stock for consistent shot placement. (see Picture 1)

The extractor is set in a groove inside the rim of the bolt face. Thus, unlike the Mauser claw (controlled round feed), the cartridge head is uniformly supported. (see Picture 2)

Model 700 extractor is the strongest commercial design. (see Picture 3)
