

## Model 522 Viper

1193-Present

The Viper magazine is curved and should be aligned with the housing at a slight angle. The latch may need to be depressed as the clip enters the housing.

The Viper is designed to operate with .22 long rifle ammunition only.

The Viper stock is made of DuPont Rynite, a high-quality synthetic that is both strong and light weight.

The Viper was designed with the younger shooter in mind as has a heavier trigger pull as a safety measure. Another safety measure is that the Viper will not shoot without the magazine in position.

Ejection failure problems are most likely to be caused by a broken ejector.
