Thank you for your inquiry, and welcome to Remington Country. The product WD-40 is not a lubricant. It can not "crystallize" metal, however it can, over time, cause a very bad, sticky build up which can interfere with the operation of the firearm, as well as cause safety concerns when used on the trigger and safety mechanism. We do not recommend use of this product on our firearms.
