Thank you for your inquiry. According to the information provided, this firearm was manufactured in or around 1981. We have a Safety Modification Program on certain model bolt action rifles. This is a voluntary program, it is not a recall. This is designed to remind people of the existence of the bolt-lock feature and to offer customers the opportunity to modernize their products. If you have a bolt lock safety, we strongly recommend that you take advantage of this offer.

Model 700 ADL can be converted to the BDL with hinged floorplate style but not to a detachable magazine. Dimensions of the detachable magazine receivers are different and key parts are not interchangeable. Please contact your local Remington authorized repair center or parts distributor for pricing information. To perform the conversion you will need the following parts:

- BDL style stock
- Trigger guard
- Magazine box
- Magazine spring
- Mag. follower

We do not offer rebarrelling or sell rifle barrels.

As with any used firearm, we would strongly recommend you have the firearm serviced and evaluated by a competent gunsmith for function and safety.
