I inherited a Remington 660, .308 winchester. After doing some background searching on the net, I found some literature that indicated that there could be a potential problem with the safety, specifically the gun accidentally firing when the safety is switched off after the trigger has been played with. Is this literature correct and if so can I e-mail you the serial number from the gun for confirmation that Remington repaired the problem.

Second if Remington has not corrected the recall item, how can I go about getting the issue fixed. I live in Canada and I understand it can be quite difficult to ship a gun to the US.
