There are currently no recalls on the Model 700 center fire rifles. We do have a bolt lock modification program for the model 700 series rifles that were manufactured prior to 1982, which had the bolt lock safety. This means on the guns manufactured prior to 1982 they have an old style safety that must be placed in the F or Fire position in order to load and unload the firearm. We apologize for any inconvenience you may be experiencing. We suggest taking or sending your firearm to a Remington Authorized Repair Center or our factory for evaluation.
