Thank you for contacting Remington Country. We can check to see if your Model 700 has ever been involved in a recall if you will forward the serial number.

We are offering a conversion that you may have heard of in which the bolt-lock can be removed on models produced before 1982. The unloading process for most bolt-action firearms with a bolt-lock mechanism cannot begin unless the manual safety is placed in the "F" or "Off or Fire" position.
