I have 2 older rifles, a Model 722 and a 40x with triggers like this. The program involved sending the rifles to you where they would be inspected and a new safety added that allows the bolt to be opened, or the trigger would be replaced.

Is this still available?
The 722 is really a hazard since, if the safety is not engaged 100% and the trigger is pulled, the gun won't fire, but the firing pin releases against the safety. So, when the safety is switched off, the gun fires! And there is no way to stop this from happening since the bolt cannot be opened to remove the cartrige from the chamber.
