I recently bought a model 600 in .222. It has a vented rib, serial # 3070. The barrel has a Heart stamped in the barrel same side as bolt/right. Could you give me more details on this model. The gun is deadly accurate. I don't think the safety/recall has been performed. Just before the heart stamp is lettering RER? with circle around it.
