Thank you for visiting Remington Country. The Remington Model 600 Bolt Action rifle was introduced in 1964 and discontinued in 1967. We made approximately 95,000 of these guns during this time. According to the information that you provided, your Remington Model 600 was produced in or around 1964. The rate of twist on the Model 600 in a Gma caliber should be 1:9 which indicates it will stabilize heavier bullets in that caliber. We would suggest that you review the information found on our homepage in the Safety Center entitled "Bolt Action Safety Message: Safety Modification Program for certain pre-1982 rifles."
