THANK YOU FOR YOUR INQUIRY. THE POLICE SEAR AND TRIGGER ENGAGEMENT ARE POLISHED. THE SENDERO AND VARMINT ARE NOT.

THE 700 POLICE STOCK IS PRODUCED BY HS PRECISION AND THE 700 VARMINT/SENDERO STOCK IS PRODUCED BY BELL & CARLSON, BOTH OF THESE STOCKS HAVE ALUMINUM BEDDING BLOCKS THAT BED THE ACTION AND FREE-FLOAT THE BARRELS, HOWEVER, THE BEDDING BLOCK IS LONGER IN THE POLICE STOCK.

THE 700 POLICE HS PRECISION STOCK HAS A WIDER FORE ARM AND IT HAS TWO SWIVEL STUDS ON THE FRONT.

THE 700 LTR HAS 3 A-SYMETRICAL FLUTES IN THE BARREL WHICH FACILITATE WEIGHT REDUCTION AND AIDS IN HEAT DISAPATION. THE FLUTES ALSO HELP HARMONIZE THE BARREL.

POLICE HAVE PARKERIZED FINISH AND THE 700 VARMINT HAVE A BLACK OXIDE MATTE FINISH.

THE ROT (RATE OF TWIST) IS NORMALLY DIFFERENT SINCE THESE TOWN MODELS ARE DESIGNED FOR DIFFERENT USES THEY REQUIRE DIFFERENT GRAIN WEIGHT BULLETS. THE ROT IN THE BARREL IS DESIGNED TO PROVIDE OPTIMAL PERFORMANCE FOR THE GRAIN BULLETS THAT ARE NEEDED FOR THE DIFFERENT APPLICATIONS. NORMALLY THE BULLET GRAIN WEIGHT FOR VARMINT/SENDERO HUNTING IS LIGHTER THEN THE BULLETS DESIGNED FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT USE.
