Remington is proud to offer a version specifically designed with kids in mind – the 20 gauge Model 870 Wingmaster Jr. This well-balanced, versatile shotgun is the appropriate choice for young hunters and joins the Model 870 Youth, designed for the older youth or small stature adult, in the extensive family of Model 870 shotguns.

Built on the lightweight 20-gauge, 3-inch Model \$70 platform; the Wingmaster Jr. has a high-gloss American walnut fore-end and stock, shortened to a 12-inch length of pull (one inch shorter than our Youth version and two inches shorter than our standard Model 870). The vent rib Remi<sup>tM</sup> Choke barrel is 18 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> -inches in length and comes with Full, Modified and Improved Cylinder cheke tubes for balance, case of handling and versatility in the field. Both barrel and receiver have a high polish blued finish.

As that young hunter matures, simply replace the butt stock with a standard youth or adult version; add interchangeable Rem Choke or rifled barrels and this reliable pump action will provide a lifetime of hunting memories.
