


FIRST KNIFE IN THE REMINGTON OUTDOOR EXPLORATION SERIES" INTRODUCED

Madison, NC – Remington Arms Company proudly announces a new collectible series of knives celebrating the exploration of the American wilderness with the use of a compass. Four knives in total, representing the North, South, East and West, in the Remington Outdoor Exploration Series will be offered and each comes packaged in its own handsome four-color display box.

The first in the series is a traditional two-blade trapper representing the **North**. Both the Remington logo and traditional "Remington Country" compass face with the corresponding direction are etched on the clip blade. In addition, a coined "compass" shield is embedded on the genuine ig bone handle of this limited edition knife. The clip blade and the spey blade both measure $3^{-1}/_4$ -inches in length and are constructed of durable stainless steel. The ScotchbriteTM coating on the blades baves a brashed-book finish. The overall length of the knife measures $7^{-1}/_2$ -inches and when closed, a compact 4 $1/_4$ -inches in length.
