Express – burchwood stock with non-reflective and non-revealing finish is finished the same way as special purpose except that it is not hand polished.

Express – camo – realtree advantage

Wingmaster – walnut stock with high gloss finish on the wood, polished blued metal finish, wingmasters have fine line scrollwork (they are embellished or engraved)
Wingmster – camo – mossy oak break-up pattern

Special Purpose – camo - mossy oak break-up pattern Special Purpose- finish – (steps) goff blasted, hand polished. 180 grit sand, final finish, it has a black oxide finish

Ejector – the ejector is located on the barrel (semi-auto ejector is on the barrel instead of the bolt)

Vent Rib – the width of the vent rib is 3/8 inch

Wingmaster – rem choke system Express – 1 choke

(note: pre 1960 shotguns can not shoot steel) (note: no shotguns are stariffess steel at this time)

870 trigger pull  $-3\frac{1}{2}$  - 5 prids

front bead sight - 146 X 48 (express has a front bead only) middle bead sight - 096 X 56 (special purpose & wingmaster have both the front and mid-bead sight)

(note: on the matte finished 870 barrels the front bead sight is pressed in)

870 Supermags – you can put regular 870 barrels on the supermags but than you are limited to what the barrel is made for.

870 Supermag – camo – mossy oak 870 Supermag – flat finished & a hardwood stock
