


REMINGTON INTRODUCES FIVE RIFLES CHAMBERED FOR SIZZLING NEW VARMINT CALIBER - THE .204 RUGER

Madison, NC – Varminters were introduced to an amazingly fast, flat-shooting centerfire cartridge with the unveiling of the new .204 Ruger in 2004. Matching this ballistically balanced cartridge with the "out-of-the-box" accuracy of the Remington® Model 700^{1M} line, takes varmint hunting and long-range shooting into the 21st century. For 2005, Remington will chamber the .204 Ruger in the following rifles: the newly redesigned Model 700 VS SF II, the lightweight Model 700 LV SF, the new single shot Model XR-100^{1M} Rangemaster®, the new value-priced Model 700 SPS^{1M} and a laminate version, Model 700 VLS. All rifles are drilled and tapped for scope mounts and deliver the legendary Model 700 accuracy needed for long-range shooting.

Model 700 VS SF II (Varmint Synthetic, Stainless Fluted) – New for 2005, this varmint synthetic, heavy barreled version of the Model 700 has received upgraded features in response to our customers' requests. The reconfigured H.S. Precision composite stock has a contoured beavertail fore-end with defined ambidextrous finger grooves, palm swell and twin front factical-style swivel stude to accommodate sling and bipod. The stock has a tactical green/black webbed textured finish. The 26-inch heavy contour, stainless barrel has a concave, target-style crown and six longitudinal flutes for rigidity, increased heat dissipation and weight reduction. The exposed metalwork features a spin polished finish. Suggested retail price: \$1025

Model 700 LV SF (Light Varmint, Stainless Fluted) – Introduced in 2003, this lightweight varmint rifle is designed for the varmint hunter on the move. Weighing a mere 6 ${}^{3}/_{4}$ -pounds, the Model 700 LV SF features a stainless steel short action receiver that is pillar bedded, blind box magazine and jeweled bolt. The 22-inch, clean stainless steel barrel has a medium contour and is fluted to decrease weight and increase heat dissipation. The custom designed, black composite stock features semi-beavertail fore-end, swivel studs and Remington's revolutionary R3TM Recoil Pad: Suggested retail price: \$919

Model XR-100 Rangemaster New for 2005, this competition-ready, single shot rifle features an externally adjustable Model $40-X^{TM}$ target trigger = a first for Remington in a standard production rifle. Trigger pull weight can be adjusted from $1^{4}/_{2}$ to $3^{4}/_{2}$ -pounds. With a solid bottom receiver design, the Model XR-100 has one of the most rigid actions available which forther enhances accuracy. Additional features include thumbhole laminated stock with rollover checkpiece and beavertail fore-end with lightening vent cuts for improved heat dissipation. The 26-inch, heavy variant contour barrel has a concave target crown and is finished in satin blue. Suggested retail price: \$879
