- We need to establish a protocol to insure that our varmint rifles meet a level of accuracy that is congruent with the consumers perception that a varmint rifle should be capable of delivering MOA accuracy out of the box.
- We already charge more for these guns, but we can likely get an additional premium
 if we can guarantee a level of performance.
- We need to firm up our future business of high revenue, high margin products and give the consumer "insurance" in the form of a guarantee that they are justified in paying the premium for a varmint rifle vs. a price point rifle.
