I attended the Remington Armorer's School at the factory in Ilion NY about 5 years ago. The shotgun portion of the school was very good. We were given in-depth instruction concerning the 870s, and 1187s. I was looking forward to the M-700 phase of the course, however, that was the one part of the Armorer's school that I found lacking. Instruction focused on disassembly & inspection, cleaning, and very basic repairs such as replacing the extractor. Adjusting the fire control, head-space, barrel crown, etc are not covered, and they are presented as "out of bounds" for the police armorer. Any maintenance of that nature is to be carried out by the factory. There is also nothing concerning scope mounting that is covered in the course.
