What about Model 600 and 660 rifles? Most Model 800 and 680 rifles (gissis some XP-100%) were recalled and repaired in 1979 to safety reasons related to the trigger assembly Medicaco and 660 rifles were manufactured (or retrofitted) with bot-lock feature.
