For all rifles except certain model 600's and 660's and some XP-100 target pistols, you will be charged \$20 for the cleaning and inspection of the gun, and removal of the bolt-lock, plus shipping and handling.

When the rifle was first produced, most post WWII rifles were produced with the bolf lock safety and (most) shooters were familiar with the feature. Now because firearm training is so different, and consumer demands have changed, we are providing an option for owners of pre '82 rifles to have the change made

to their rifle and also to make people aware that the feature exists.
