Bolt-Action Safety Modification Program Notice

Notice of Change in Operation - Non-Bolt Lock Centerfire Firearms:

Due to the changes in the trigger assembly now installed in your Remington firearm, it will no longer be necessary for you to put the safety in the "F" or "fire" position to load or unload the firearm. Your rifle can now be loaded and unloaded while the safety is kept in the "S" or "safe" position.

However, you must still follow the 10 Commandments of Firearms Safety in handling your firearm. Always keep the muzzle of any firearm pointed in a safe direction, especially when you are loading or unloading. Keep the safety engaged in the "S" or "safe" position at all times until you are actually ready to shoot. Always unload your firearm when not in use. Always unload your firearm as soon as you have finished shooting - before taking it into your car, camp or house. For further information on firearms safety visit us at www.remington.com
