> Per our conversation this morning, I have seven 30-06 guns to ship to
> Mike Keeney's attention. I spoke to Phil Reesor and Scott Franz and we agreed to ship to Mike initially
> because of his involvement in the test early on. Each gun has a different combination of detent spring
> types and pivot pins. The guns will require additional analysis by the test lab. We haven't discussed the
> details of the plan yet, but Scott did mention an abbreviated DAT/T&P test is needed. I don't know if the
> tests will be destructive or not, so I'm not sure if the guns will be usable following test.
