Subject: Centerfire issues

Folks,

A few things came up in the centerfire area today. I wanted to get them relayed, so the night shift has an idea of where we stand and also so the dayshift can begin looking at each item first thing.

The first issue is the end labels on the CDL Mags. The 26361 and 26367 both call out for 20" barrels on the end labels, but the guns are actually 22" long. I was able to catch Steve and Mark and we fixed the 26367, but the 26361 came up later. We can pack the 6367, but not the 6361. Rick Lewis will need to correct the 6361 before we can pack these.

Next we have 2 issues with the model 7 fire controls. The first is we have a number with the model 700 safety arm on them. These are in actions as well as in our stock. Jim will have someone screening the crib. The builders on night were watching what they built with, and I had Mike Wescott screen all the actions we have subbed up and change them. The ones I saw were from either fire control builder 1 or 24. The second issue was the safety arm retaining clip is not being rotated so as to lock on the detent knobs. My builders were watch for this also and Jim's guy was going to look for this as he screened the crib.

52 CLD Mag stocks are sorted out and by Ed Lesniak's desk. These are for a test run for the quality team, please do not use them tonight. They have eng. tickets asking for them to be held.

Standard CDL stocks did not come in today as once thought, only the Mag. Stocks.

Also on the shotgun side, the 5307 will be pack and stack. We will be shipping from here.
