General	How many Remington Model 700's have you made?	We have made over 4,000,000 since 19xx.
	They said you looked at the gun owned by the Barber family that discharged, what did you find?	Yes, we did look at the firearm.. As a matter of record we do not comment on the condition of any individual the firearm..
	Is the TPA in the Model 700 ML the same as your centerfire rifle?	Yes, the Trigger Plate or fire control is of the same design. However, the natural build up & corrosion capabilities of the propellants used in muzzleloading firearms require additional care & cleaning in order to maintain proper operation..
	Should I be concerned about the safety of my other Remington firearms?	As with all Remington firearms, including the Model 700, when you adhere to the "10 Commandments of Firearms Safety", and properly maintain your firearm and do not make inappropriate alterations to your firearms, your Remington firearm is safe..
	As a result of this accident, what is Remington's future course of action?	As provided in the statement to CNN. The entire Remington family is saddened by this tragic accident and we extend our condolences to the Barber family. We are redoubling our efforts to educate hunters in the safe use and proper maintenance of the rifle and of all firearms. The popularity of the Model 700 is attested to by the fact that 4 million of these rifles have been sold to hunters, target shooters and law enforcement agencies across the United States. When used following the rules of safe gun-handling, including proper maintenance, and not inappropriately altered, the Remington Model 700 is a safe rifle. Bolt Lock safety	Please tell me if my gun has a bolt lock style safety	With a bolt lock safety gun, the safety must be in the "f" or fire position for you to open the bolt on the gun. This contrasts to a non-bolt lock safety firearm where the gun safety can be in either position in order for the bolt to be opened. So in order to test your gun, follow the principles outlined in the 10 commandments of safety, get the firearm out of your gun safe, get the bolt (which should be out of the gun when stored), pick up the gun, make sure that there are no rounds in the gun (chamber and magazine), and that the safety is in the safe "S" position. Install the bolt, close the bolt and then try to open the bolt with the safety still in the safe position. If it will not open, make sure your finger is not on the trigger and that the gun is pointed in a safe direction and install the bolt. Put the safety in the fire "F" position.
	When did you switch from a bolt lock style safety to standard safety?	In 1982
	Can I get my firearm, which has a bolt lock safety installed updated to a current non-bolt lock safety? How much would it cost?	Yes. We can do it for you in the factory. The cost for this service is _____. If you would like to do this we would be glad to clean your firearm at the same time. There will be no charge for the cleaning service, just the replacement of the bolt lock safety. When we change the safety, we will install an entirely new trigger assembly which includes a non-bolt lock safety.
	Why would I want a bolt lock safety on my firearm	You may want it for certain hunting applications. For those that do want it, is a matter of personal preference. An example of why someone may want it is that they are traveling, (walking or riding) through heavy brush and wants to have his gun loaded and ready to fire. The individual does not want to take a chance that the bolt handle would be opened up by a foreign substance and then when they get ready to fire the firearm the gun would not work as the bolt handle has been lifted. Note: We do not recommend having your gun loaded as you travel through the woods.

Safety	How can I tell if my firearm is safe	
	How can I tell if my gun has been altered - Check cleanliness of gun - Check functioning of gun - Have gunsmith review	It is very difficult to do. The best thing to do is to take it to a qualified gunsmith (or send it to us at Remington) who can look at the various settings of the screws and then identify if it in fact has been altered. When we manufacture the firearm we lock tight various screws on the fire control (TPA). It is easy for someone qualified to tell if the gun has been altered by seeing if the seals have been broken..
