

Remington Model 700 Centerfire Rifles

In the middle of the last century, a major advancement forever changed the American firearms landscape: The Remington Model 700. Back then, it was a revolutionary design. It still is. What sets it apart is the fashion in which it all comes together. The cylindrical receiver design is far more rigid than traditional flat-bottomed types. Aside from adding stiffness, this provides a more consistent bedding area for the action in the stock. Next comes a counterbored bolt face that completely encloses the cartridge head with an unbroken ring of steel. This ring feeds inside the barrel chamber and, in turn, is surrounded by the receiver. The result is the famous Remington “three-rings-of-steel” – undoubtedly the strongest action ever conceived. Of course, strength is not the only hallmark feature of the Model 700. Its accuracy makes it the envy of every other rifle maker. Such status is the result of many factors: A completely supported cartridge means snugger chambers and more exact alignment of the cartridge with the bore. The cylindrical receiver and unique bedding design also come back into play – forcing the barrel to come to rest in the exact same place every time, maximizing consistency from shot to shot. Finally, the exceptionally crisp Model 700 trigger assembly features an ultra-fast lock time of 3 milliseconds which dramatically minimizes the effects of shooter

movement. All of these features are balanced through proprietary manufacturing processes to produce the renowned Model 700 out-of-the-box accuracy.

Remington Models 7400 & 7600 Centerfire Rifles:

Regardless of why you need a second shot, the Remington Model 7400 and Model 7600 rifles get you back on target instantly. Not only are they built to deliver legendary Remington first-shot accuracy, they're also designed for ultra-fast follow-up shots – without ever having to un-shoulder your rifle. For autoloading fans, there's the gas-operated, soft-recoiling Model 7400 auto-loader. Prefer a slide action? There's the Model 7600 pump. Both feature quick-release magazines and Remington's rotary bolt lock-up design for exceptional strength, safety, and hallmark reliability.

Remington Models Seven & 673

While the Model Seven is considered by many to be the ultimate dense-cover rifle, don't underestimate its range. The Model Seven still features the rigidity of Remington's Model 700 action and delivers exceptional accuracy for long-range shots. Remington has also introduced the Model Seven Magnum, which combines the performance of full-size, long-action magnum rifles with the legendary portability and quick handling of the Model Seven line.

The Remington Model 673 is based on the Model Seven action and builds on the legendary reputation of the Remington Model 600 Magnum, a rifle sought after by big-game guides across the country for decades. The swift-handling Model 673 features a 22" magnum contour barrel with a machined steel ventilated rib and iron sights. It is the definition of fast target acquisition. However, aside from being a performance oriented firearm, it is handsome as well. Each Model 673 is bedded in a two-tone, wide-striped

laminated Monte Carlo style stock with deep cut checkering and swivel studs.

A 2" shorter overall length than the Model 700 makes the Model Seven perfectly sized for shooters of smaller stature.

The Model 673 is built on the Model Seven action, features a machined steel ventilated rib and iron sights for fast target acquisition.

Model 673 rifles feature a high strength wood laminate stock with stylish alternating light and dark stripes, reminiscent of the legendary Model 600 Magnum.

Remington Model 710

The Model 710 shares many of the same hallmark features as the Model 700. The same unequalled out-of-the-box accuracy. The same time-honored reliability. The same crisp, single stage trigger design. The same ultra-fast lock time. And the same famous "three-rings-of-steel" for superior action strength. But, while much of the Model 710's base design is owed to its heritage, its real story starts with advancements made possible through today's most modern technology. Principle among its many remarkable features is a rugged barrel lock-up design. The rear of the Model 710 barrel is machined specifically to mate with three unique locking lugs on the bolt face. When the bolt is fully engaged in the forward position, it locks directly and securely inside the barrel – rather than the receiver – for unprecedented strength. Additionally, the fiberglass-reinforced nylon receiver insert is blended with Teflon and silicone before molding for continual self-lubrication and ultimately smooth operation. A short 60-degree bolt throw makes for convenient loading and unloading, as well as faster follow up shots. Beyond the superior mechanics, the Model 710 features a detachable, dual-stack steel magazine. The button-rifled barrel is hydraulically pressed to the receiver and the stock is offered in a gray synthetic, uniquely textured finish with raised cheekpiece.
