I purchased a Mod. 700 in the early 80's, after several years of use the stock was showing it's age so I bought a Remington synthetic stock which has been in place for about 3 years. I recently noticed that the safety no longer locked the bolt from turning. Fearing that it was only a matter of time before the safety would no longer lock the trigger, I had my local dealer ship the gun to you for repair. When I received my gun there was a letter explaining that the action was an old model that had been installed into a new style stock and this had caused binding in the safety mechanism. I was also billed for \$32.50 for making this adjustment. Finally my question is why was there no warning with the new stock to indicate that this problem could occur? Both pieces were manufactured by your company and I had to pay to get the two to mate properly. Also when was the last time you ever heard of a consumer having to pay to have a safety issue resolved. You didn't score any points with me. But I'm sure your response to that is BFD.
