They both have bolt locks (the bolt won't open with the safety on). I have read that this configuration was discontinued in 1982, but these guns were purchased new in 1999. Do you make them both ways?

Anyway, I have since had Ultra Light Arms (ULA) conversion kits installed which allows your safety to be used in 3 positions (safe w/bolt locked, safe with bolt open, and fire). The one thing I dislike about the safeties on both rifles is that walking through the brush sometimes flips the safety lever to fire. Are you working on a solution to this?
