We do not recommend adjustment of trigger pulls on any of our firearms, unless done by an authorized gunsmith. Because of this policy, we do not have specifics available for this type of adjustment.

When there is a concern with a part within a firearm, we recommend having a Remington Authorized Repair Center evaluate your firearm. If the trigger pull is beyond factory specifications, they will be able to correct this.
