The Safety Modification Program is not due to an engineering defect; it is an attempt by Remington Arms to remind shooters of firearms safety and to modify firearms manufactured pre-1982 so that the firearm can be unloaded when the safety is in the safe position. Once the modification is completed, you will be able to work the action with the safety on. Since your firearm has fired when you took the safety off, I would strongly encourage you to have your firearm evaluated, cleaned and modified.
