I put a BSA Platnium (3.5x10x50) scope on it, I shoot Remington Premier 120 gr. nosler ballistic tip bullets, and could not be happier with the results that I have gotten with this gun. I have not missed one deer and only had to go about 20 yards for the furthest tracking. Most of them drop right in their tracks, even the one I got yesterday (I even shot this one left handed, I am a right handed shooter).
