Thank you for contacting Remington Country. Your firearm, manufactured in 1994, was designed to enable you to open the bolt with the safety on. This will allow you to unload the firearm with the safety still engaged. Model 700's produced before around 1982 had a bolt-lock and you would have to put the firearm on fire before you could open the bolt to unload.
