Thank you for your inquiry. The Model 700 Police has a McMillan stock and the Model 700 Varmint has an HS stock. The Police has a parkerized finish and the Varmint has a black matte finish. The only internal differences is in the trigger assem., on the police model the sear and trigger engagement are polished. Both triggers are adjustable, however, we do not provide information on adjusting them and we do not reccomend it. The police barrels are pulled from the same production run as the varmint barrels. Unfortunately, we can not provide information on accuracy due to the fact that we do not guarantee the accuracy therefore we are unable to compare them.

Customer (Michael Severin) I have been trying to find out the differences between your 700 vs and 700 PSS. I know the PSS has a different stock with swalling at the front while your VS is a standard Varmint type rifle but are any of the internals different?

I also heard that your barrels are hand selected for the PSS over the 700 VS. Is this true as well?
