Dear Dana, Thank you for contacting Remington Country. Remington issued a voluntary program to convert older model rifles with a bolt lock system to a non bolt lock system. This allows the user to unload the firearm while the safety is kept in the "S" or "On Safe" position. The operation of your firearm will not otherwise be affected. All of our bolt action rifles have had this design since 1982. Please see the link below for more details on this program and on your rifle specifically.
