Dear Remington: I have owned a Model 700 BDL rifle (7mm Rem Mag) for about 12 years. I have never had any problem with it so recently, when I was in the market to buy another one, I purchased another 700 BDL (55 - .30-06). This one has the bolt lock on it (J-key). I guess that was a design change. My question is that I've heard that there might be some safety issues with the new design. That when you switch the saftety from "SAFE" to "FIRE", there have been some reported instances of the rifle firing. While I haven't experienced this problem I would like to know if this is an issue? Also, I understand that a mechanical safety is no substitute for proper gun handling (i.e. muzzle discipline). Just would like to know if this is a problem with the gun before it happens Thanks you for you attention and response. regards,
