Thank you for your inquiry. We began producing the Model 700 without the bolt-lock in the early 1980's. This allowed the user to open the bolt and unload without having to put the firearm on fire. You could keep the safety on to unload which would be a safer situation. To view the safety modification program details, go to the site listed below.
