i've had this rifle for about 25 years. although i seldom shoot it, it's been very accurate, and well cared for. i decided to take it hunting this past week, and as i was unloading it [you have to put the saftey in the fire position to unload it], it went off by my left ear [which is still causing me a problem]. i knew i didn't have my finger on the trigger, but???????????? i then replicated the process without a shell in the gun, and it did it again. i then took off the stock, and thoroughly cleaned the trigger and bolt mechanism with a degreaser and solvent. the rifle now seems to operate properly, but i don't feel especially. what's the deal? also, there appear to be better designs now, with a three position saftey in which guns can be unloaded without putting them in the fire position. finally, am i going to get my hearing back? it's only in the left ear, and i've got another good ear, but it is disconcerting. doug truslow 803-256-6276. po box 1465 columbia, sc. 29202. thanks for a response.
