I ran few more inspections this morning, including intentional setup for a "follow down" condition in which the sear does not engage the firing pin head when the bolt is closed. I had a copper crusher in the chamber to verify firing pin indent, upon inspection of the crusher after the "follow down" there was a very light indication of firing pin contact but significantly less than amount required to ignite a primer. This result is as intended for Remington bolt action rifles. If the sear is not in the proper position when the bolt is closed, the firing pin head will follow the cam cut in the bolt body thus controlling the forward translation of the firing pin in such a maner as to ensure the energy in the firing pin at full travel is far less than that required to ignite a primer.

Based on visual and functional evaluations, no indication of potential cause for the claimed "fired on bolt closing" malfunction was found. The firearm will be shipped today (7/31/02) to Paducah Shooter's, attention Adam.
