Steve and John,

The Outdoor Life gun test is upon us again. Jim will need two lion guns for the test. He needs a 700 LV SF (caliber of our choice) and a 870 20 GA cantilever slug gun. Both of these need to be hand selected and shot for accuracy. The M700 LV SF needs to be accurate, and the trigger needs to be set at process minimum (we failed to do that last year on the M673 and got gigged big time for sending out a gun with a 6.5lb trigger - can't let that happen again). Please make sure that both of these guns are given the attention they deserve. This test is a big deal and needs to be treated as such. We need to have these guns to Jim by mid January. Please notify me when they are ready and we will get an order in to ship them against.
