- Model 40-X stainless steel right hand short action with M-24 Powder Coat Finish Engell
 - Serial Number to contain "FBI" suffix
 - Receiver rolled as Remington Model 40-X
 - Bolt will have same finish as M-24 bolt
 - Bolt handle will be welded to bolt body
 - Bolt plug will be powder coated to match receiver
 - Scope mounting holes will be over sized to 8-40 same as M-24

- Each rifle will include spare parts to take rifle to its specified service life Nagle
 - Space parts should be packed with tools and cleaning supplies if possible.
 - Each spare part package should be labeled with part number, description and quantity included
 - Each rifle will include a operators manual (modified M-24 manual)

- Entire system will be packaged in our standard M700 Police TWS Pelican case for shipment Engell
