Firing Mechanism Examination Process

Question	Yes	No
1. Is there the appearance of any rust on any of the Trigger assembly parts		
2. Is there any dirt or grime on any of the parts within the trigger assembly parts		
3. Does there appear to be any sticky substances (grease, oil etc.) on any of trigger assembly parts that would inhibit its functioning		
4. Do any parts appear to be worn that would cause the gun not to function properly		
5. Do any parts appear to be damaged or broken		
6. Has the sear engagement adjustment screw settings been altered in any way (has the seal been broken)		
7. Have any of the seals on any of the other Trigger plate assembly screws been broken, tampered with		
8. Firearm received with a safety related concern, MUST BE RETURNED TO THE FACTORY		

If any of the questions were answered by a **yes**, Do not return it to the customer unless the trigger assembly has been changed, or properly cleaned and lubricated, or the customer has signed a waiver **NOTICE OF DECLINE OF REPAIR** when the customer

refuses trigger assembly replacement. Notice must be attached to the firearm and a copy retained for your records.
