We produced a malfunction in this trigger assembly as follows: cocked the bolt, put the safety on and hulled the trigger - the safety held as it should [did not fire) - then the safety was moved to "fire" position and the trigger pulled again but then the sear failed to trip (did not fire); however a few more pulls on the trigger and it suddenly fired. Like most trigger malfunctions we have found, this one may be difficult to reproduce, may require several attempts to demonstrate but if you keep trying it will occur, Although this particular malfunction is not the same as most recent ones it is closely related to the overall problem. Hope it is of some help to you.
