## LUBRICATION AND MAINTENANCE

WARNING: Frearme must be regularly eleganed and lubricated at least once a year to keep them in a safe and reliable operating condition. More frequent cleaning is required if the firearm is used under adverse conditions.

**WERICATION** 

Over-thribation should be evolded at all times. A thin coat of Rem Oil helps to prevent runting. See Note below.

Yinen the firearm is to be stored, it should be carefully cleaned and thoroughly clead. Outside surfaces chould be whood with a light cost of Rem." Of occasionally.

When frourn is to be reused, all excess labrication must be removed. The chamber and bere must be thereughly wlood dry.

NOTE: Remington Rem  $^{\infty}$  Oil is available from your local dealer. If your doaler is out of stock, ask him to order Rem  $^{\infty}$  Oil from his Remington distributor.

## TO CLEAN THE BARREL

WARNING: Check the chamber and magazine to make cure there are no cartridges in the frearm.

1. Use the equipment provided in a good cleaning Lit. For recommendations, see your Remargton Authorized Gunantin.

3. Select the corract cellbor obersing brush and attach the brush to the cleaning rod.

4. Put the desiring brush into the gun cleaning solvens.

NOTE: Burral should by horizontally with the election port faning down during cleaning. Always clean the barrel from the chamber and to the muzzle.

5. Push the cleaning brush through the borrel several times.

push through the bore.
7. Repeat several times, using a new cleaning patch each time, und the parch le not city.

8. Push a bloan patch saturated with Rem Oll through the bearel.

10. Apply a thin coat of Rem Of to the outside of the

burret with a soft closm cloth.

11. After clossing the barrel, clean the receiver and the trigger assembly.
